

How to Set up CardGuard®

CardGuard offers key card management benefits with enhanced ease of use and safety:

- Single sign on from mobile app so the you do not have to manage separate passwords
- Lock or Unlock the card
- Spending limits for the debit card
- Controls for transaction types, Merchant types, Locations and Spend Limits
- Alerts for transaction types and limits

STEPS REQUIRED:

1. Remove cards from CardValet and delete the App

- a. Turn on any cards being used in CardValet
- b. Remove alerts and controls
- c. Unregister cards
- d. Delete CardValet App

2. Upgrade to New Fremont Bank Mobile App

- a. Apple App Store or this link
- b. Google Play or this link

3. Install new CardGuard App

- a. Apple App Store or this link
- b. Google Play or this link

4. Start CardGuard from New Fremont Bank App

- a. Use your valid login credentials
- b. Once you have downloaded the New Fremont Bank App, navigate to Account Services -> CardGuard - Card Controls option
- c. Clicking on CardGuard - Card Controls option will direct you to the CardGuard App

5. Register cards in CardGuard

- a. Register the Fremont Bank Debit card by clicking on the Add Card and entering:
 - Card Number
 - Security Code (3 Digit Code)
 - Address
 - Expiration Date
 - SSN Number (Last 4 Digits)
- b. Enter the 6 digit Security Token, which is sent to the email address on the system record
- c. Accept the Terms and conditions and Privacy Policy
- d. Select Control Preferences for the card added
- e. Set Alert Preferences for the Card added
